



This Agreement supplements the User Agreement regarding the use of TrustSource between CUSTOMER and EOS. It is valid for the duration of the User Agreement and is established by exercising the rights associated with the COMPANY COMPONENT MANAGER role.

With the COMPANY COMPONENT MANAGER role, we provide a powerful function for working on the Component Base to our Corporate and Enterprise customers who request it. This function should only be used by competent, trained and responsible employees (see 4.ii).

Exercising the rights of this role is not mandatory for using TrustSource. It was created to speed up processes. By exercising, or assigning the role to users, you agree to the following supplemental terms of use. If you do NOT agree to these terms, you may NOT assign the role to any of your users:

Terms of Use Company Component Manager Role

1. Role motivation

The role was created to accelerate the handling of compliance tasks, especially in the preparation of metadata. In many places in the open source component space, metadata is insufficient, or non-existent. TrustSource helps collect and curate this data, among other things, as well as provide the legally required documentation. Up to now, the metadata management function was mainly performed by the TrustSource team. With the help of the COMPANY COMPONENT MANAGER role, the CUSTOMER also gets the opportunity to participate in these tasks.

i. Challenge

TrustSource provides many mechanisms for obtaining metadata. However, many open source projects often have solutions that are simply not or insufficiently documented or provided with legal information. This repeatedly leads to challenges, some of which can only be solved by asking questions or manually. Therefore, fully automated curation is not yet possible.



ii. Goals TS

TrustSource's goal is to provide optimal support to clients in achieving compliance. To achieve this goal, TrustSource provides both identification and curation support. However, a conclusive, legally compliant basis cannot always be guaranteed for all situations or components due to the sometimes incomplete factual situation on the open source provider side.

iii. TrustSource Support

TrustSource does not provide legal advice, but it is always possible to contact TrustSource support for questions regarding metadata or for assistance in obtaining metadata. The support is available at support@trustsource.io for any corporate or enterprise customer. However, this capability is limited to the availability of appropriately trained and capable staff. A general service level or response time cannot be guaranteed at this time.

iv. Company Component Manager Role

Subject to the conditions described below, EOS will permit CUSTOMER to exercise or, assign the COMPANY COMPONENT MANAGER role to appropriately empowered employees in order to place the curation capability on a broader, self-organized basis.

2. Role competences

The role is equipped with the possibilities to edit the existing metadata as well as to add new ones. This concerns both the legal information of individual and all versions of a component, as well as the internal links, CPE information or further information such as sponsoring organization.

i. Change options

Users with the role can

- Change metadata for components
- Create new versions
- Change license information of single or multiple versions
- Add or change copyright information
- Define or change CPE key

ii. Training video

iii. My Critical Components Report

The owner of the role will find an additional report in the ANALYSIS section, which will show him components that need his attention. This report is accessible only to the role owner. It only concerns components that are also used in the respective company.

iv. Add details and findings

Changes are applied directly. Explicit saving is not required.

v. What cannot be changed?

Of course, there are also limitations. For example, it is not possible to adjust the internal ID, the TrustSource Key, of a component or to change the privacy status.

3. Impact and consequences of changes

Basically, changing the metadata is an act with far-reaching effects. The data is used for all analyses. The data is always based on the last version of the component information. Changed information therefore leads to changed interpretations. Changes in these data affect not only the own project but all users of this instance. As a rule, this is a "shared" instance, which means that all users of TrustSource.

i. Optimistic regulation

EOS relies on responsible use of the powers of this role in the interest of lean and fast processing. It is assumed that the power of this role will be applied only by thoughtful and responsibly acting staff. Thus, all changes will take effect immediately.

ii. Logging

However, all changes are logged and will subsequently be verified by EOS employees or technical plausibility checks.

iii. Control

EOS reserves the right to revert changes, should they prove to be untrue or describe legally incorrect or doubtful facts. In such cases, affected users will be informed.

iv. Liability

Deliberate falsifications or negligent modifications, e.g. modification of a license in favor of better usability against better knowledge or the declaration of a false "effective" license without detailed examination, etc., will result in penalties of 5,000 EUR per individual case. Any claims for damages exceeding this amount shall remain unaffected, but the penalty payment shall be credited.



4. Requirements for the use of the role

To perform the role, the following requirements must be met:

1. Your company or you need a TrustSource *Corporate* or *Enterprise* account.
2. You, as the role holder, should have gone through and understood at least the *TrustSource Basics Training*, the *TrustSource Compliance Manager Briefing*, and the *Component Manager Responsibilities Briefing* (see. [Trainings](#)).
3. An Account Admin from your company will assign you this role.
4. You acknowledge that you have read and understand this User Agreement Addendum.

5. Other regulations

1. Validity

By exercising the role, the user agrees to these terms and conditions. The use of TrustSource is also possible without the exercise of this role. There is no obligation to exercise this role. However, exercising the role gives rise to the obligations described here.

2. Severability clause

The invalidity or unenforceability of one or more provisions of this Agreement shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Agreement. The same shall apply in the event the agreement does not contain a provision that is necessary in itself. The invalid or unenforceable provision or the gap in the provision shall be replaced by a legally permissible and enforceable provision which, in the opinion of the parties, comes as close as possible to the economic purpose of the invalid, unenforceable or missing provision.

3. Law and jurisdiction

The law governing the interpretation of this User Agreement shall be German law, and the place of jurisdiction shall be defined as the registered office of EOS.
